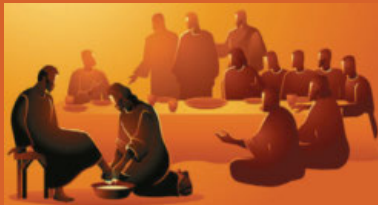
Dear St. Robert's parishioners and friends,
