Blessings to you and your family!

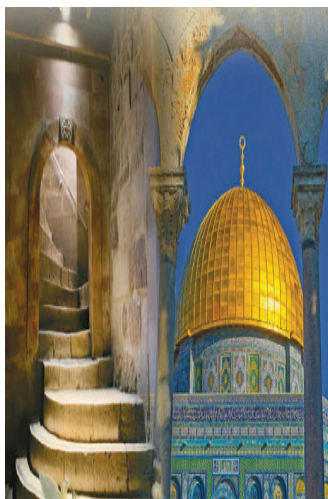

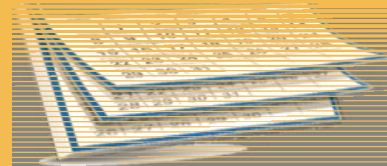
