

## St. Roberts Basketball

### Frequently asked Questions

How many evaluations:	There will be two evaluations for grades 5 <sup>th</sup> thru 8 <sup>th</sup>
What about 4 <sup>th</sup> Grade:	Since 4 <sup>th</sup> grade is a training league, there will only be one evaluation. 4 <sup>th</sup> grade is split into two even teams while 5 <sup>th</sup> grade through 8 <sup>th</sup> we start to split based on ability.
When & Where:	The evaluations will start November 1, 2011 at the San Bruno Recreation Center
What date will my child's Evaluation be?:	Your child should be available between Nov 1-Nov 13
Who can try-out:	Any player who is a student of St. Robert's or an active participant in St. Robert's Religious Education Program (CCD).
How many teams per grade:	This is determined when all the participation forms are received. Once we give the league our numbers this cannot change. (Thus the importance of the participation form deadline!)
How many players on a Team:	Our minimum number is 7 players, but it comes under the discretion of the basketball commissioners and/or the Athletic Board.
Who evaluates:	The evaluators all have basketball experience and are selected by the basketball commissioners.
What do the evaluators Look for.	Dribbling, passing, shooting, team play and knowledge of the game Any student who does not attend evaluations or is new to the school may have a separate evaluation or subject to team placement by the Athletic Board, Principal or Pastor before the rosters are due to PPSL.
What is the cost:	\$75.00 participation fee and \$50.00 facility fee.
Participants/Players:	Attend both evaluations Sign and understanding the player's code of conduct.
Parent Commitment/Responsibility:	Participation fee Sign and understanding the parent's code of conduct MUST WORK ONE CENTER PLATE PER SPORT YEAR WHETHER YOUR CHILD PLAYS 1 OR 3 SPORTS.
