Dear Parents,

The Confirmation Program at St. Robert's Parish requires a significant commitment. Our program involves a 2- year preparation period prior to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please be sure your candidate and your family are willing to make these classes a priority before registering.

Year I, all Ninth grade students (or older who have not received Confirmation) are required to attend Confirmation preparation classes on scheduled Tuesday evenings from September through May. Classes will be held in Hennessy Hall from 7:00 – 8:30 PM.

Year II, all Tenth grade or older students (**who have completed Year I**) are required to attend Confirmation preparation classes on scheduled Sunday afternoons from August through October (approximately 5 class sessions). Classes are held on Sundays from 3:30 – 5:00 PM followed by mandatory class attendance at the 5:00 PM Mass. No absences are allowed during the second year.

Enclosed with this mailing you will find a registration form and a calendar of classes. Please post the calendar in a clear location as students may not miss more than 3 class sessions. The expectation is that students and their parents will cooperate in fulfilling this commitment. **Students who miss 3-5 classes must attend a make-up class in May. Students missing more than 5 classes will need to repeat Year I.**

The first class will be an orientation class on **Tuesday evening, September 28, 2010**. It is our hope that at least one parent of each student attend this session.

Please return your completed registration form with a copy of your child's Baptismal certificate before September 17, 2010. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to call or e-mail us at the numbers above.
