Things you may want to know this week

- **1.** This Sunday, August 22, we celebrate the **21st Sunday in Ordinary Time** in our church liturgical calendar. We will have our First School Family Mass at 9:30AM. Ordinarily, when August 22nd does not fall on a Sunday, we celebrate the Queenship of Mary. With the school's acquisition of Mary's statue, Mary's Queenship will be celebrated and honored at school. The statue will be mounted on the hill behind the play structure so that Mary will be looking at our children while they play at the school yard and as they go to school. Certainly, our school will also be doing a May Crowning next year.
- 2. As to the **grotto of our Lady** in front of the church, it is still in progress. We are looking at the best way to proceed. So is the **heating project** at the church. We already received two bids with more questions to ask before we finally decide. As parishioner **Pat Ryan** always reminds me: PNP-Progress Not Perfection. I had to remind myself through St. Theresa of Avila's words: PWE-Patience Wins Everything.
- **3.** I will have another back-to-back Funeral/Memorial Masses tomorrow for two of our parishioners: Christopher Adan, whose 52nd birthday falls tomorrow and Zuzana Larios, (more info expected)
- **4.** SF Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone sent a Memo to all priests in the Archdiocese regarding the **request for religious exemption** from vaccine mandates of their employers on the grounds of their moral objections to the vaccines. The archbishop has asked us not to give such letters of exemption and to, however, refer them to his office. On the other hand, Pope Francis and some cardinals released a video encouraging people to get the vaccine (see video below). Parishioner and our young vaccine ambassador, Ryan Quock, has put up another video, featuring our own parishioners expressing their reasons why the vaccine is important. So, better get your vaccine now!
- **5.** The email phishing has continued. Our parish secretaries have received a separate email supposedly from me with a bogus email add: revpastor12@clergy.com, informing them that I changed my bank and to change my direct deposit details. Please be extra careful with this kind of fraudulent email. Do not easily bite their bait, call the parish office for anything suspicious.
