# LIVING THE LITURGY

## Ascension Sunday

Again this year we celebrate the Ascension on a Sunday instead of the Thursday many of us grew up with. My guess is that the bishops felt that the feast got lost celebrated on a weekday when so many needed to work and "squeezing in" Mass was difficult, if not impossible. The feast is important because it expresses our belief that when Jesus' mission was finished, he returned to the Father, leaving the Spirit and the rest of his work in our hearts and hands! And what was his work, we might ask? To announce the reign of God, the values of that kingdom where God is the center – the Lamb seated upon the throne as we heard two Sundays ago – and everyone is welcome. His loving us to the end frees us from our estrangement from God (original sin) and we are through our baptism in him, made his brothers and sisters and children of his Father (salvation). But most people, including most Catholics I daresay, don't know this, or at least haven't let it sink into our lives. We don't have to worry about being worthy or whether God loves us! What other evidence do we need than Jesus' life, death and resurrection and Ascension? But we can't live this mission out without the Spirit whose coming we will celebrate next weekend.

This weekend, providentially, we'll also have the opportunity to sign up for the Life and Dignity e-mail alerts so that we can put our faith and values into the important civic issues of our time. So please sign up! And do pray for the gift of the Spirit to our leaders and to all the Church. God is faithful. Lord, send out your Spirit – renew the face of the earth!

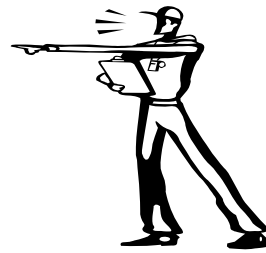
