It's hard to imagine that two weeks ago I was in Oslo, Norway with my wife, my wife's aunt and her husband. It was a beautiful sunny day as we toured the sites of the city especially the Vigeland Sculpture Park. This park has free admission and depicts through sculpture the joys and struggles of life's relationships. We also visited the Nobel Peace Prize Museum. We had a wonderful visit and the people were so happy and pleasant.

One week later the city and country are devastated by an act of domestic terrorism. I couldn't help but feel immense sadness for the people whose country was so hospitable to my family and me.

The Gospel this week starts with Jesus hearing of the death of John the Baptist, his cousin. Jesus is moved in such a way that he retires to a boat and heads across the water to a lonely place. Like many of us when we hear of the death of another we feel a little depressed and have to spend some time alone with our thoughts and prayers.

I wonder how Jesus felt, when he saw the crowds coming. He probably wished for more time alone, but it was not to be. He needed to continue his ministry to God's people. Jesus meets the people where they are. He understands their needs. He reaches out to them with love.

Jesus, please reach out to us and the people of Norway. Share with us your gift of love. May we be an example of God's love to one another.
