Many thanks to each of you who donated hundreds of packages of macaroni and cheese, jars of peanut butter and jelly, cereal, tuna, graham crackers, raisins, canned fruits and vegetables! 54 parishioners, ranging in age from preschoolers to 80 year olds, counted, sorted and bagged six weeks worth of nutritious child-friendly food these past Mondays and transported the groceries to Belle Air School on Tuesdays. We are very grateful to those of you who gave monetary donations of over \$3500 which enabled us to purchase milk from Dollar Tree and tortillas from La Tapatia each week.

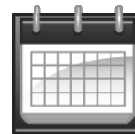
The Second Harvest Food Bank provided more than 5700 pounds of fruit cups, bananas, melons, oranges, peanut butter, cereal, snack crackers, granola bars, trail mix, onions and carrots. San Bruno Lions Club made a major donation as did Sysco Foods. Donations of gift cards and grocery bags came from Trader Joe's, Millbrae and South City; Safeway, Millbrae; Costco and La Tapatia, South City; Walgreen's, San Bruno; and Lucky's, Hickey Blvd, Pacifica.

Did you Know?

Child sexual abuse is a great deal more prevalent than many imagine. In fact, studies tell us that one in ten adult men and one in five adult women say that they were molested before the age of 18. That means that, directly or indirectly, child sexual abuse will touch most of us during our lifetime. And although we would like to believe that most accusations are false, the facts tell us that children rarely lie about being molested.

In fact they rarely tell anyone at all. An adult study about the prevalence of sexual abuse found that 42% of men and 33% of the women who were victimized as children never told anyone.
