### Interested in Advocating for the Elderly?

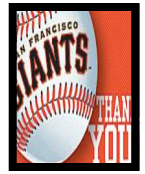

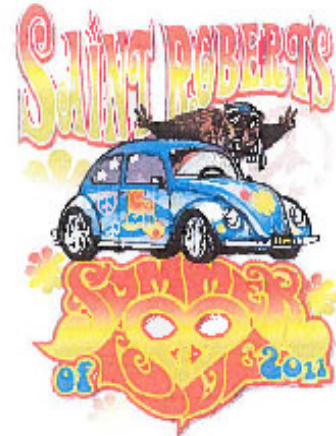
