Dear Parishioners

Most people are already emotionally fatigued from the weeks of continual disaster coverage in the news, plus a continual stream of recap reports, interviews, film, and commentary about this weekend's ten-year anniversary of the 9/11 attacks and the one-year anniversary of the San Bruno gas line explosion and fire.

To ask anyone to read yet another remembrance here would be "piling-on"; so perhaps it's better just to reflect on two connections between these events and the Gospel message.

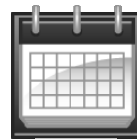
Mixed among the complex soup of emotions we feel is a vague sense of spiritual anxiety. While peace, health, and prosperity bring us comfort and a greater confidence that God is with us and blessing us, disasters like these strike at both our comfort and our confidence by removing the most tangible signs of God's presence and blessing. This weekend is a time to remember that God has given us an exceptional – and enduring sign of His love in Christ, who laid down his life for us.

As these anniversaries churn up the sense of loss in our hearts, the associated anger comes back up, as well; and we might find ourselves wishing that God would "even the score" with those responsible for the deaths and destruction. Today's Gospel selection (which has been in this position in the 3-year cycle of readings since before either of these disasters) gives a timely reminder that our willingness to show mercy to others will affect God's willingness to show mercy to us. Jesus teaches us to pray for God to share with others the same graces and blessings that we wish for ourselves.

On this doubly-somber anniversary weekend, let us keep in our hearts and minds the victims of these tragedies and the words and deeds of Christ, who suffered, died, and rose to make salvation available to all. And let us keep the Prayer for Divine Mercy ever on our lips.

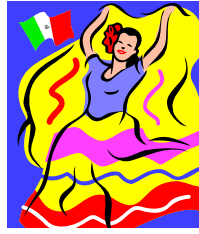

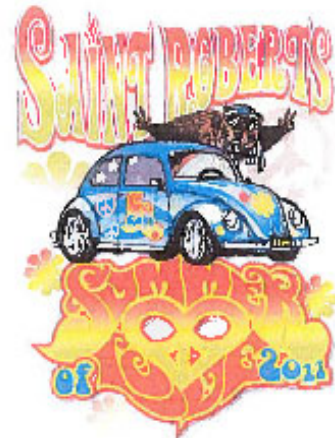
