Dear Friends,

I sit here in Gene's big, blue chair, sipping Ginger-Snap tea, while I study the readings for today. I ask Gene to please help me find what it is that God is saying to us.

We both like the story of young Samuel. He was called early in his life to have a special relationship with God. It isn't just a few chosen ones with whom God wants a personal relationship – He wants this relationship with you and with me. Samuel was sleeping when he heard his name called. In order to hear God speak to us, we must be still. We need to clear our minds and take the time to listen as did Samuel. ***"Samuel grew up, and the Lord was with him."***

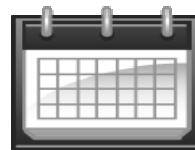
In the second reading, Paul tells us that our ***"bodies are members of Christ...whoever is joined to the Lord becomes one Spirit with Him...your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God."*** God, Our Father, created each of us for this singular purpose --- to know Him; to love him and to serve him here on earth and then to be happy with him forever in Heaven. We, like Samuel, are growing up spiritually and the Lord is with us.

In today's Gospel according to John, we watch John the Baptist point Jesus out to two of his disciples. One of them is Andrew, who looks for his brother Simon and tells him that he has found the Messiah – the Christ. Andrew then brings Simon to Jesus and their journey together begins. Our journey with Jesus can begin this day when we listen to Jesus call our name and respond to Him with these words: ***"Here am I, Lord: I come to do Your will."***
