Called to Community

Today is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, the mystery of our Triune God in whose image we are made, called to be a community of love as our God is! There are many ways in which God's love is evident in our parish; last summer's six week grocery program was one of the most touching for me. Last summer with the economic downturn affecting many of our families and coworkers, we still gave generously to our hungry neighbors for six weeks! We won't need to do that again this summer, since the Food Bank with the cooperation of the parishioners from First Filipino United Church of Christ has moved the distribution site to Belle Air School! This is where we distributed the groceries last summer and now the Family Harvest program will provide families with 120 lbs. of groceries year round on the fourth Wednesday of the month. Many thanks to the First Filipino folks who were willing to move from their church (behind Wendy's) to Belle Air School. This past Wednesday at the new site, the 55 families previously enrolled grew to 72 families at 450 3rd Avenue and to more than 85 by the time we finished. Now the program is located where the need is the greatest!

5 or 6 UCC parishioners will be coming each month. I'd like 4 or 5 of our parishioners to come each month as well, so there are sufficient people to unload the trucks, sign up new families and help distribute the food. So that we don't overwhelm them, could you please let me know if you'd like to be part of this rotation? The next distribution day is June 27 from 2:30 to 4:30 pm. I still have fliers on all the food programs if you can help spread the word. Thank you for your support.
