I'm sure that you put a lot of thought and expense into the gifts you gave each other for Christmas. Yet, probably some of those special gifts were returned on the day after Christmas.

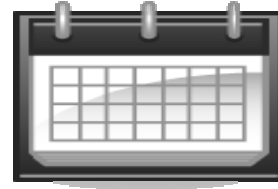
