Dear Friends,

Here I sit in Gene's big blue chair, sipping Vanilla Chai tea. Though the sun is shining brightly and the sky is clear blue, it is much too chilly to be out on our deck. Even Gene's white butterfly has the good sense to stay out of the cold. I ask Gene to help me write this letter to you. Quietly I wait. Now these thoughts come:

Today we are in the midst of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Christians of every denomination share the faith that Jesus is our Lord, our Redeemer, our God. He loves us so much that He died to forgive our sins and bring us back to our Merciful Father, so that we can have an intimate, personal relationship with Him. Though some of our practices may slightly differ, with God as our Father, we are sisters and brothers. We are one in Christ. Christians, let us love one another!

Monday, we celebrate Martin Luther King's birthday. The message of this courageous Christian man (for which he lost his life) is that all men and women are children of God, made in His image and likeness. Thus all humans have an invaluable worth and dignity – all are equal and must be respected and treated as equals. On Tuesday, President Obama will be inaugurated for his second term.

In today's Gospel, while attending the Wedding at Cana, Jesus listens to His Mother's request and changes water into wine – His first miracle. Jesus' presence at the marriage between a man and a woman elevated Matrimony to the status of a sacrament. Jesus was with Gene and me at our wedding here at St. Robert's forty years ago. He made us one in body, one in heart and one in soul. Jesus remains with us throughout our life together here on earth and forever in heaven. I close this letter with Gene's life-long motto.

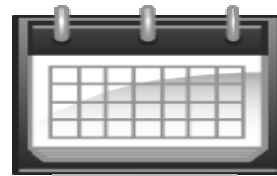

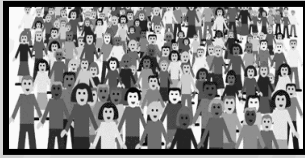
