Dear Parishioners

You may have noticed that during this liturgical year, we are blest with hearing the gospel of Luke's community. Today is one of the few Sundays in Ordinary Time; we have two more Sundays after this, then it is the First Sunday of Lent!

The readings this weekend are rich. We hear first from the Hebrew scriptures, Ezra the priest reading from the book of the law for hours. The people listen, understand and receive joyfully what they have heard. The psalm gives us a sense of the esteem with which the Jewish people held the word of God, reverencing the law as spirit and life.

In the gospel, we hear the Word of God himself proclaiming the word he has come to fulfill. He quotes a passage from Isaiah about bringing glad tidings to the poor, liberty to captives, recovery of sight to the blind, letting the oppressed go free, and proclaiming a year acceptable to the Lord. The people had, no doubt, heard this passage before, but they weren't ready for what came next. "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." We might be more understanding of their response if we recall that he grew up with these folks; as a child, he played with their children. And though he was an admired preacher and teacher, this declaration was a bit much!

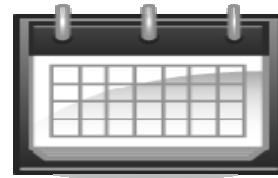
Today, we hear these two passages along with Paul's letter to the Corinthians about the oneness of Christ's body. "In one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit." What an invitation we are given as a Church, as a parish, to be one whether Republican or Democrat, young or old, lifelong Catholic or receiving the sacraments through the RCIA. From the strength of our oneness in Christ's Spirit, may the Isaiah passage be fulfilled in our lives!
