Lent is a time to stop, look and listen. May it be a time of refreshment and renewal, as we look forward to the Great Feast of Easter.

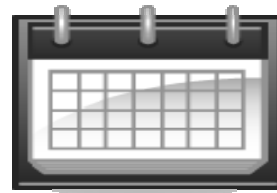

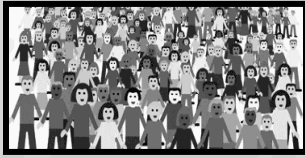
