Dear Parishioners,

This weekend's readings offer glimpses of three prominent saints, when none of them was exactly a model of virtue or reverence. Each was acutely aware of his unworthiness and insufficiency to the call he received: Isaiah confesses himself to be "a man of unclean lips, living among a people of unclean lips." Paul refers to himself as "the least of the apostles, not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the Church of God." And Peter implores Jesus, "depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Acknowledging personal unworthiness and insufficiency created a space in them for God's power to work in and through them.

Some of the most well-recognized saints didn't start out particularly holy, like Isaiah, Paul, and Peter here; like Augustine, Ignatius of Loyola, and Francis of Assisi. Seeking God's will in their lives brought them to mission, through which they were transformed by God's power and bore great fruit by God's grace. Whether we sense ourselves to be as ill-equipped as Isaiah, as insufficient as Jeremiah, as impetuous as Peter, or as unworthy as Paul, God's call comes to us through our Christian Baptism – to bear Jesus' Spirit in our hearts, and to follow Him in witness to the Gospel and service to the poor, the sick, and the suffering... to seek our share in that ongoing mission of love and mercy... and like those saints, to be transformed by God's power and bear fruit by his grace.

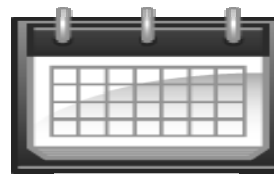

### Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving

If you grew up Catholic or have come into the Church via RCIA, you'll recall that these three practices are the heart of Lent. Our parish has taken on various forms of almsgiving over the years: contributing enough to build a well in Malawi; buying anti-malaria bednets; helping Fr. Nanna add on to his church in Nigeria; and last year, spreading the word about food availability for poor families in our area. This Lent, our parish will be participating in Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl efforts. We are encouraged to "give up" something and place what we would have spent in the cardboard "rice bowl" we'll give you next weekend. We'll also learn about our neighbors far and wide and their needs. 75% of what we donate will assist poor families in other countries; 25%, local poor families. Thank you in advance! 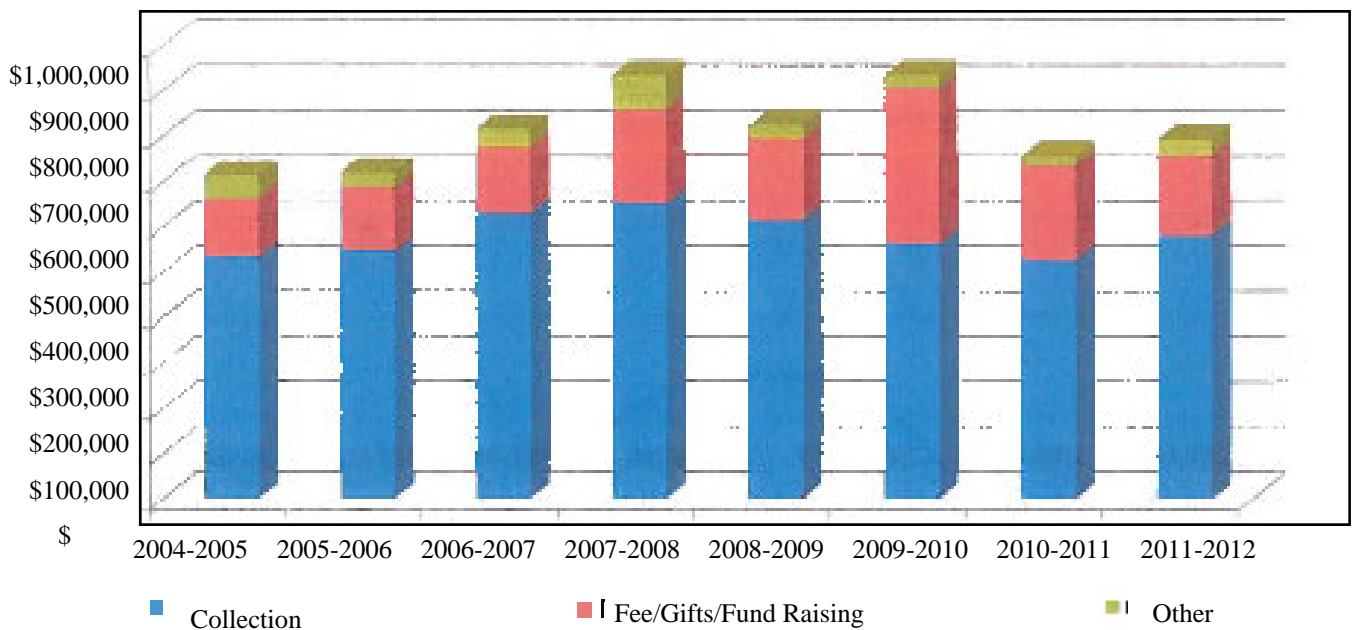

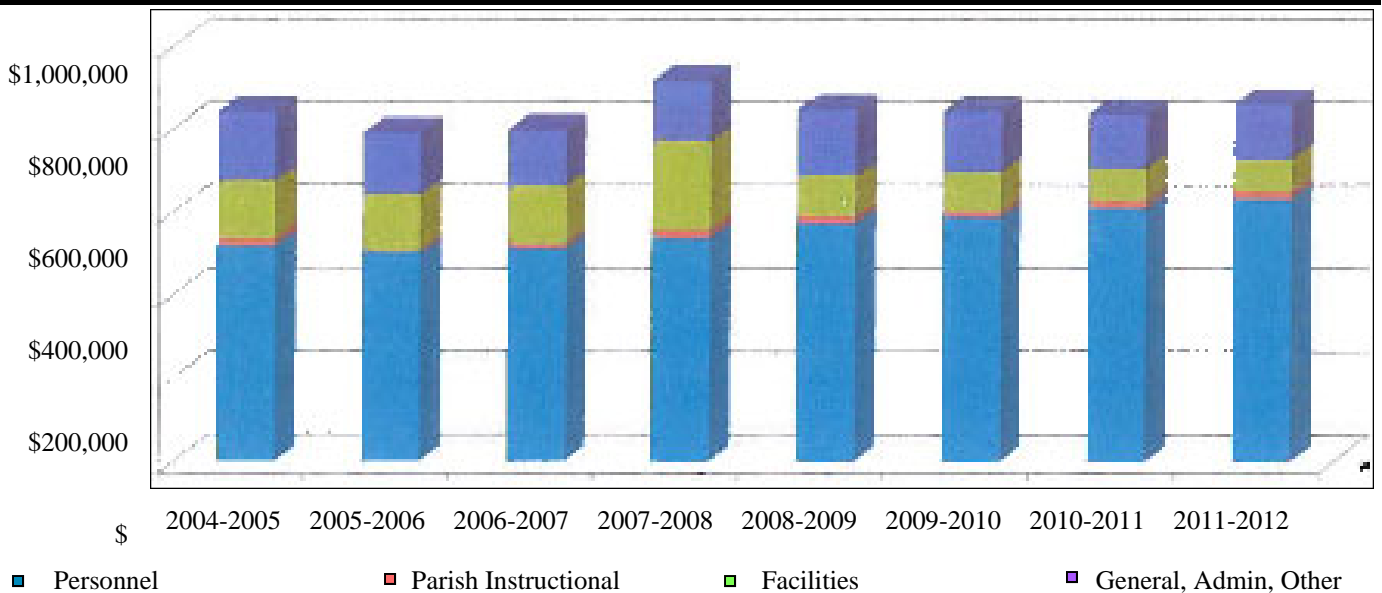

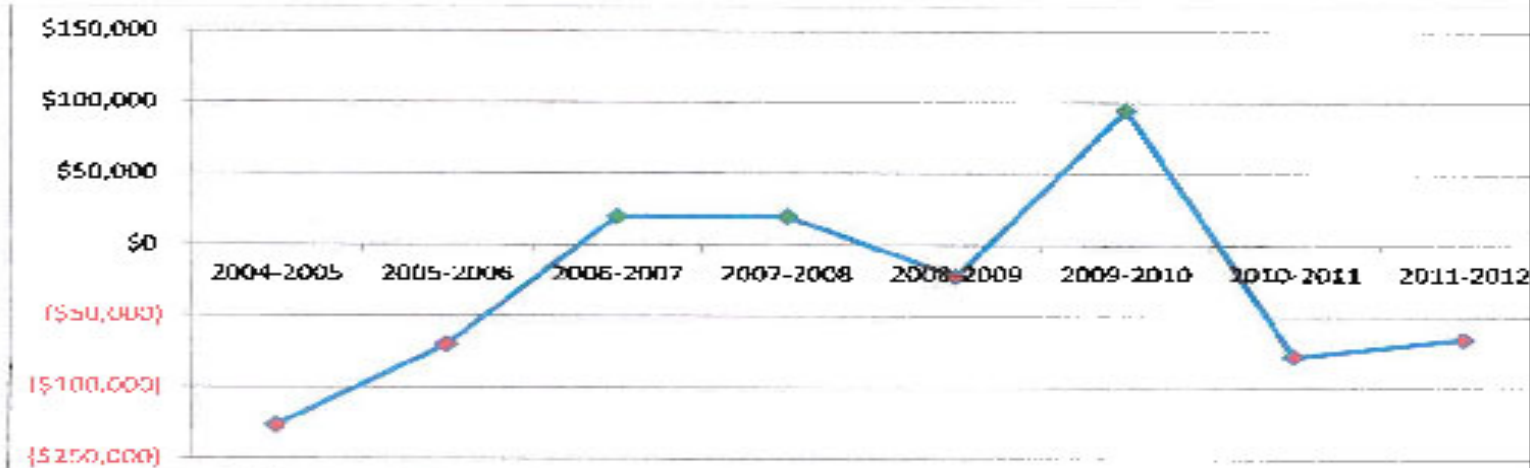
