Over a hundred years ago, John Henry Cardinal Newman gave a sermon during the Easter Season called "Witnesses of the Resurrection". In this Sermon, he recalled how the scriptures tell us that over five hundred people witnessed the Lord after His death and resurrection, but he made the point that it was not only they, but us today, that are the witnesses of His resurrection in our lives.

Although we didn't know Jesus, when He was alive, we hear His voice through the Scriptures, we experience His presence through the Sacraments and we touch Him, in the love that we have for one another.

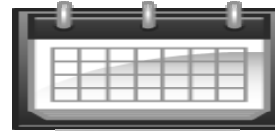
We celebrate that Jesus is Risen, not two thousand years ago but today through the faith and hope we have in Him.
