Dear Friends,

Sipping mango tea, I sit on our deck under Gene's crab apple tree, resplendent with pink and white blossoms. Like hundreds of tiny butterflies, they rain down upon me. John's Gospel for today is one of our favorites. I ask Gene to remind me of what we thought when we read it together. We picture Peter gazing toward the shore at the man who told them to cast their nets to the other side of the boat. Peter wonders who this man might be. Is he a fisherman who knows where the elusive fish are hiding? When John says: **"It is the Lord"**, Peter immediately jumps into the sea and splashes his way to shore, dragging behind him his net filled with fish. His only desire is to be with Jesus. When we want to be with Jesus, we need not jump into the sea and swim to shore: Jesus is already here – His Holy Spirit lives within each of us. All we have to do is call out His Name!

Jesus (the same compassionate God Who weeps with us in our sorrow) sees that His friends are tired and hungry. He cooks breakfast for them and invites them to join Him at His fire. Jesus sees that we too are hungry – hungry for Him -- for His forgiveness, peace and love. Jesus invites us to join Him at His table and eat the meal He has prepared for us – a meal of bread and wine – transformed into His Body and Blood.

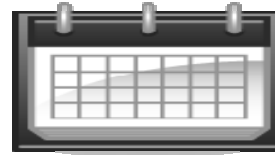
After breakfast, Jesus calls Peter aside and asks him: **"Do you love Me more than these?"** Peter replies: **"Yes, Lord, You know that I love You."** Jesus says to Peter: **"Feed My lambs."** Three times Jesus asks Peter: **"Do you love Me?"** Just as Peter denied Jesus three times on the night before He gave His life for us, now three times Peter earnestly replies that he does love Jesus. Because of Jesus' choice of this weak, yet repentant, Fisher of Men, we have grown from a tiny remnant of followers to more than one billion Catholics now led by Pope Francis I in Peter's unbroken line of successors.

Jesus has a special place in His Merciful Heart for those of us who are weak and afraid. As Jesus has forgiven Peter, He forgives us for the many times we have denied Him. Jesus' love for us has washed away our sins. He asks only that we tell Him we are sorry; love Him and love one another. During this Year of Faith, may we come to know Jesus; grow deeply in love with Him; and then do what He told Peter to do: **"Feed My lambs...Tend My sheep"**. When we do this, our faith increases and embraces all whose lives we touch with the Love of Christ.

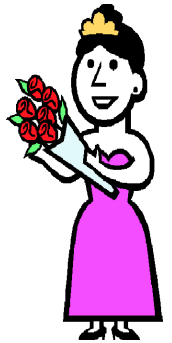


