Are you at peace?

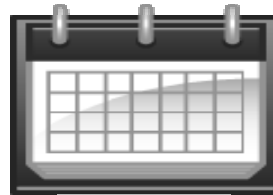
Ordinarily we tend to think of peace as an absence of conflict – between nations, with family members, coworkers or neighbors, or between differing inclinations of our heart. Peace also commonly refers to a personal quiescence, an inner quietness and an absence of anxieties.

In the 14th chapter of John, Jesus tells his disciples about the gifts he will give them after he leaves them (in his Passion and death) and comes back to them (in his Resurrection). In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells them: "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you." And he points out that it is not like the ways we think of peace, but the peace that can come only from union with God – the adoption as children of God. Think of the greatest peace you can recall experiencing, and know that it was but a foretaste of the peace that awaits us in the Kingdom.

We continue to seek and work for peace wherever we find conflict or distress in life, following Jesus' command to love one another as He has loved us, and making room in our hearts for God to make his dwelling. And through the indwelling of God's spirit, we can partake of his peace and grow more confident in our hope that the fullness of love from which our life sprung will embrace us in the fullness of peace, without limit, and without end.
