Before I take my first sip of refreshing mint tea, Gene's white butterfly lands on a purple petunia perched on the glass-top table beside me. We're off to a good start! I ask Gene to help me discern what it is the Holy Spirit wants to tell you concerning today's readings.

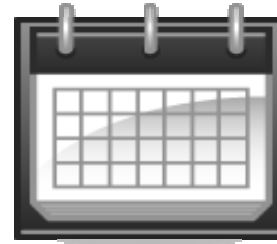
St. Paul reminds us: ***"stand firm...for you were called for freedom...serve one another through love. For the whole law is fulfilled in one statement, namely, you shall love your neighbor as yourself... Live by the Holy Spirit."***

We sometimes forget that our God loves each of us as if we were His only child. Because of His Fatherly love, He sent His Beloved Son Jesus to die for us and He has given us His Holy Spirit to live and work within us. Through the urgings of His Spirit, good thoughts come to us. Answers come to us. God is speaking to our hearts. He asks us to be a blessing to others. We can do this in so many simple ways: A phone call to someone who is lonely, ill or grieving the loss of a loved one; a smile and cheerful "hello" to each person we meet in church, along the street or at the grocery store; a listening ear for someone who needs to be heard; a sincere compliment to a person who seldom gets any. Giving of ourselves is the most precious of all gifts. Making good things happen for others fills us with joy. When we experience joy, it is a wink from God letting us know He loves us; He is here with us; that He is blessing us.

Little things done with love can transform the day of someone who is sad or disheartened. We can step out in faith; trust in Our Lord; keep reaching out to other people and do good for them. Like this purple petunia and Gene's white butterfly, God has planted us in this place at this time for a reason. He has chosen us to reflect His love – a job that only we can do. When we awaken each morning, we can say: "What can I do for You today, Dear God?" Then delight in God, knowing that He will lead us in the right direction and give us all we need to do His will. Trust in Him --- God loves you!
