Hosanna!

I've always been amazed that some of the same people who shouted "Hosanna in the Highest" to Jesus on Palm Sunday, shouted "Crucify Him" on Good Friday.

How fickle we are about how we see people. One day they are heroes and the next week, they are villains. We rejoice when they are on top, and we relish their fall. We love to tear down the people we admire when we discover they are humans beings like us. They are imperfect and flawed.

Jesus did not respond when the people shouted "Hosanna". He knew how changeable the human heart is. Yet when they shouted "Crucify him," he asked for forgiveness for them and said they didn't know what they were doing.

How about us, do we welcome Jesus at one moment, and crucify him by our actions the next? Would we shout "Hosanna" one day and "Crucify him" the next?

Palm Sunday invites us to examine both our own lives and how we judge other peoples lives. We need to be consistent in how we see Christ, ourselves and others.

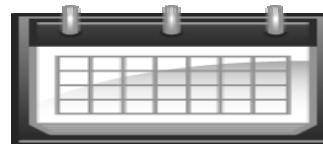
Good Friday Walk
