Dear Parishioners,

Confronted with the reality of the crucifixion and subsequent burial of Jesus, those who had come to believe in Him by his words and his works were cast into doubt, confusion, and despair. He had healed so many and saved the lives of others, why could He not save his own? He had spoken such words of hope; but as He breathed his last, death stole the final word.

Or so it seemed. Jesus – who had shown power over life and death – entered into our death, Himself, and defeated it from within. As the sinless one, the spotless lamb of sacrifice, He took upon Himself the sins of humanity and defeated them by his mercy.

The empty tomb on Easter morning reflects the emptiness of death, now defeated by Christ. Pope John Paul II wrote, “Death has justice done to it at the price of the death of the one who was without sin and who alone was able – by means of his own death – to inflict death upon death.” Christ’s death and resurrection secured his victory over sin and death, that his followers in faith might share in that victory.

We live in a world burdened by death, fear of death, and sorrow over others who have died. Easter reveals to the eyes of faith that death is not the final word; but in Christ the final word is life. May the light of the Risen Lord fill your heart and breathe newness of life into your spirit this holiest of days.

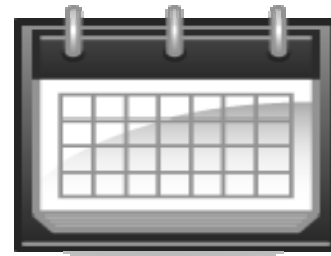
