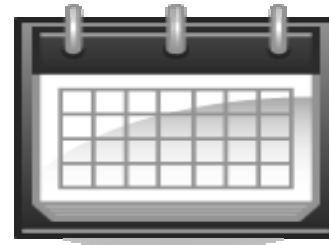

If you have a family member or neighbor who cannot come to Mass, you can either call Sr. Patricia at 589-0104 and ask her to have one of the Eucharistic Ministers bring Communion or you can bring the person Holy Communion yourself. 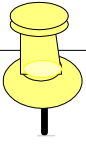
