Dear Friends,

Today is the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. I remember a June day a few years back when Gene and I sat here on our deck discussing these two very un-alike and unlikely leaders of our new-born church. We smiled into each others' eyes and agreed that God certainly has a wonderful sense of humor.

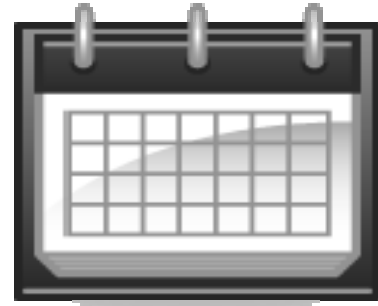
Peter - the bold, bumbling, brawny, impulsive fisherman - truly loved Jesus and meant well; but so often put his big foot into his mouth. Do we do this too? Peter was convinced that he was a brave man; but his courage quickly deserted him as he stepped out of the boat and tried to walk to Jesus on water. Do we try to do things on our own; but falter because we don't trust Jesus and ask Him to help us? Peter swore that he would die for Jesus; but when put to the test, three times he denied his friend. What do we do when the moment of truth arrives? Jesus forgave Peter and never stopped loving him as He unceasingly forgives and loves us. It seems unimaginable that Jesus chose Peter as the head of His church. Thank God for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, or how long would we or our church have survived?

Then along comes Paul – a highly educated, self-righteous, stiff-necked, opinionated intellectual. He was sure he knew everything about God and His kingdom. So much so that he tried to kill as many of Jesus' followers as he could. Paul needed to be knocked off his “high horse” and go blind before he could clearly see Jesus for Who He truly is. Does our conversion need to be this extreme? Paul then became the Apostle of the Gentiles; he continues to lead millions of people to Jesus.

If we ever think of ourselves as unlikely disciples and wonder why God still puts up with us, all we need do is remember Peter and Paul. Jesus has chosen each of us. When His love flows through us and we reach out to others; as Peter and Paul did, we too can change the world!
