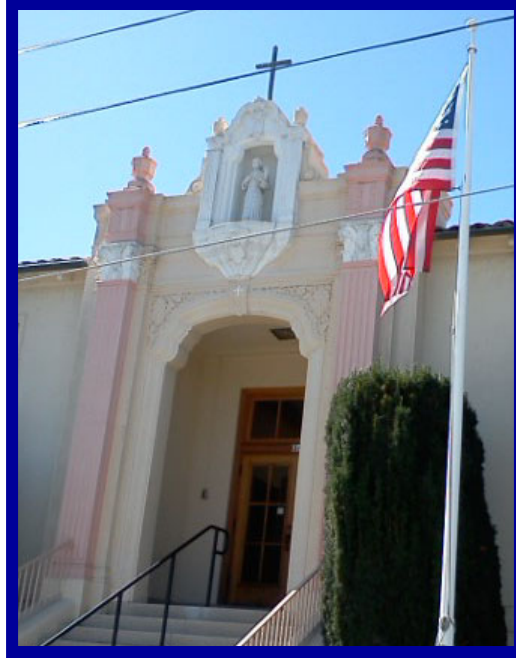

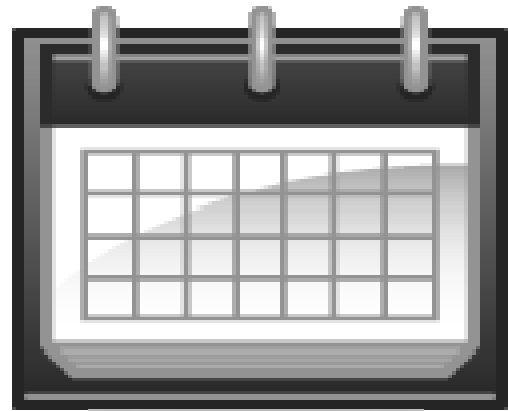
IF YOU ARE NEW TO ST. ROBERT'S
