Dear Parishioners,

June is the height of storm season in Nebraska, and during my recent visit to my father there were some severe storms and tense hours. After one night's storm rolled through, we stepped outside to watch the lightning show receding with the storm front. I noticed breaks opening up in the clouds toward the west (like the parting of a curtain) revealing the peaceful splendor of the moon and stars bright and steady against an inky black sky.

It made me think about how creation acts as a veil of sorts that conceals the deeper, eternal reality of God's kingdom, and wonder what it will look like when that veil drops away. It's always brought me some peace to remember the words of St. Paul to the Romans in today's second reading, about how creation, itself, is groaning with labor pains – undergoing the birth of the kingdom – in a mysterious manner hidden from our direct sight. And that likewise we, ourselves, are groaning within, as the birth of the kingdom within us strains toward completion. The joys and sufferings that we experience ... our victories and defeats, our setbacks and recoveries ... all become a part of this process, helping to shape and strengthen that life in us.

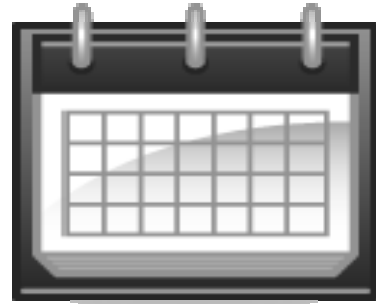
