Dear Parishioners,

Today's readings seem to focus on food! Isaiah promises that God will provide a banquet for the people in exile, raising their hopes for a better future. When the disciples want the crowds to go buy food after a long day of listening to Jesus, he instructs the disciples, "Give them some food yourselves." Some of us, perhaps, have experienced a lack of food growing up, so we have a deeper understanding of its preciousness. Some of us probably take for granted that we can buy whatever we need, so the refrigerator will be well stocked. In any case, we recognize that without food, our very lives are in danger.

The refrain of today's psalm also contains an invitation, "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs." How shall this be accomplished, if not through us? There are so many crises in our world; we feel helpless to change things and may isolate ourselves from such sad news. Some of us have more than enough on our plates already: caring for a seriously ill parent, a relative in recovery, or a special needs child.

But for the rest of us, another response might be to prayerfully reflect on what we **can** do, a small effort though it may be, to "feed" someone in need. When we have a family gathering, could we give the extra food to a neighbor who is unemployed or to the Catholic Worker? Could we go through our closets and give the clothing we no longer wear or which our children have outgrown to one of the many nonprofits who will pick items up? Might this be the week when we call the elderly person we haven't heard from in weeks? I need to do some of these things myself this week to make tangible our God's concern for each person.

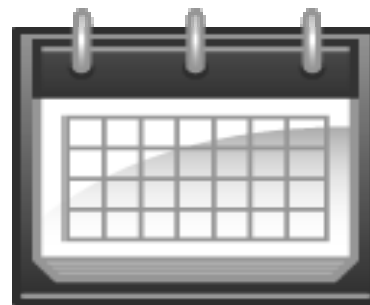
