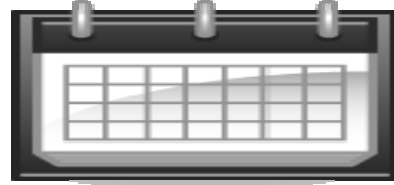
#### To the Parish,
