Dear Parishioners,

Today's readings are marvelous as we conclude the Christmas season. Through Isaiah, we are called to the water of life and the lavishness of God's kingdom. We, too, are promised the renewal of the covenant originally made with the Jewish people. On our part, we need to "seek the Lord" and let him change our hearts. His ways are not our ways, as any of us adults could surely attest, so we need to recognize that!

The gospel speaks of Jesus' baptism by John. And we, too, have been chosen to be Christians through our baptism, so the declaration by the heavenly voice applies to us as well.

What would our daily lives be like if we heard our loving God say to us, "You are my beloved daughter" or "You are my beloved son." And doesn't God say that to us many times a day through those who love us and forgive us?

Perhaps, we don't perceive it, take it for granted, or are too busy to notice. But if we believed in God's unconditional, almost unbelievable love for us, made manifest by Jesus taking on our human condition, how could we not find ways to express that same love to others? We could start with those closest to us – family and friends – and then extend that concern to the clerk at the checkout stand or the Syrian refugees.

In our hectic lives, most of us need help to even try to pray. Here is a suggestion. "Give Us This Day" is a monthly resource, available digitally or in print, with daily Scripture readings, reflections on lives of holy people (some canonized saints, some not), and brief morning and evening prayers. 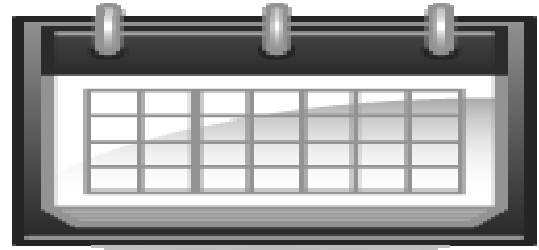
