Dear Parishioners,

This past month has given us marvelous gospel readings. On the Epiphany, people from the then-known world are "called" by a star to Jesus' birthplace. Next, Jesus is baptized by his cousin John in the Jordan and the voice of God calls out to him, "You are my beloved Son." The following Sunday's gospel according to John has many calls: John the Baptist calls Jesus the Lamb of God and leads two of his disciples to Jesus who invites them to follow him. Andrew then calls his brother Simon and brings him to Jesus. And, in case we didn't get the point, last Sunday we heard Mark's version of Jesus calling these two and then James and John. Seems as though once someone is called by God, he or she needs to call others!

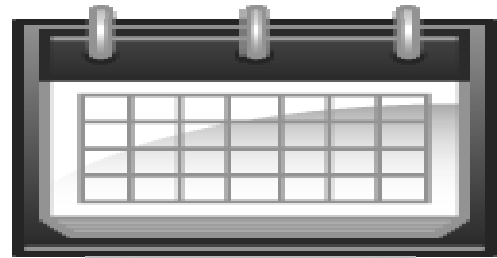
I had the first inkling of my call to religious life from my sixth grade teacher, Sr. Maura Power, RSM. She was an excellent teacher and really wanted us to learn and more importantly, she cared about us as individuals, all 40 of us. She made God's love real. I remember thinking that if I could help someone to feel God's love the way she did, that would be a wonderful way to spend my life. I actually had the opportunity to give a vocation talk with her years ago in Sacramento and to thank her publicly for planting the seed in me. (I'll gladly share the rest of my story with anyone who'd like to hear it, though it's not very dramatic.)

So how about you? How are you making God's love real? Life is much more complicated now than in the 50's, but our relationships with each other are still the most important aspect of our lives. As someone famous once said, we may be the only bible some people will ever read. What an amazing privilege and responsibility is ours by our baptism - we are called to embody God's love as Jesus did and as Maura did for me. We won't always act in a loving way, but may the Spirit help us to keep trying. Peace, S. Sheral

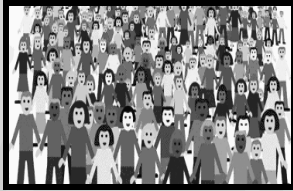
