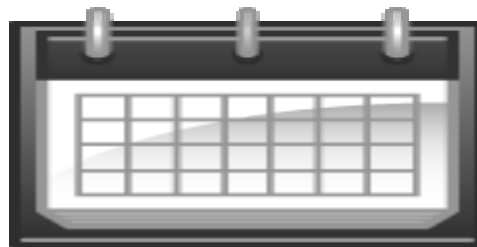

The Eagerly Awaited Encyclical

Pope Francis' encyclical on ecology is due sometime this month. Cardinal Peter Turkson, president of the Vatican's Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace, has hinted at this content. "The earth *needs* to be protected; humanity *needs* to be dignified...The current economic-developmental model is out of balance...We need to shift away from unthinking infatuation with GDP and a single-minded zeal for accumulation. We need to learn to work together toward sustainable development, in a framework that links economic prosperity with both social inclusion and protection of the natural world."
