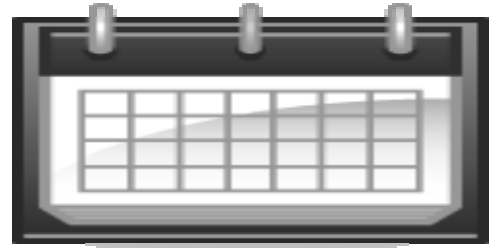
Thank you for all you have done for me and my ministry. Together we will continue so see the Blessings of God in our lives.
