Sitting here on our deck, in the midst of Gene's colorful garden, while sipping pineapple tea, the question pops into my head: "Why is it that some people always seem to be happy?" 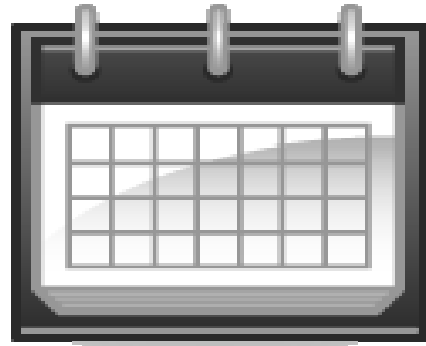

We can thank Him for our home, for food to eat and clothes to wear, our comfortable chair; for our family, friends and neighbors. When we turn the key and our good old car starts, we can say "Thank you, Lord". We remain conscious of the Holy Spirit guiding us, protecting us, loving us, and being with us wherever we go. To Him we say "Thank You". We feel our joy bubbling up within us.

The positive side-affect of choosing to be happy is, when we do this, we want to share our joy by reaching out to others; showing them that Jesus loves them and that we love them, too. We take the time to look deeply into their souls and find a need that we alone can fulfill. By taking our mind off of ourselves and being kind, compassionate and generous to others, we open ourselves to the joy with which our Father wants to fill our hearts.
