The Pope's Encyclical

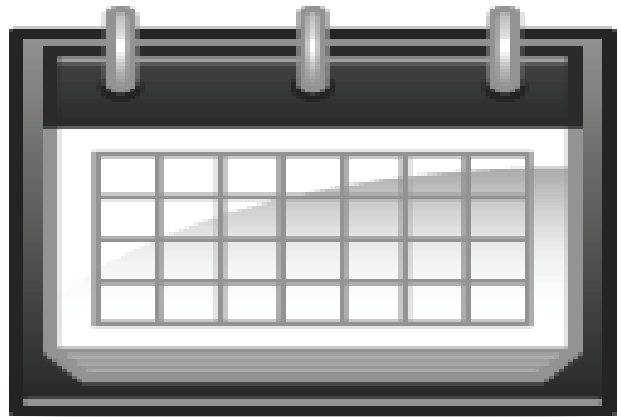
I'm willing to host a series of evening gathering to discuss the Pope's encyclical, Laudato Si if there is interest.

August 28th will be the first Men's Club Dinner, doors open up at 6 PM.

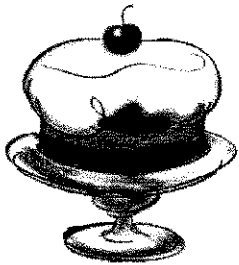
We are starting early due to Labor Day being on our regular meeting and with September being the annual Festival we decided to start early and make it a Friday night event.
