Dear Friends,

I sit here on Gene's deck, warmed by the October sun, sipping Vanilla Chai tea. The leaves on his crab-apple tree are turning yellow and gently drift down upon me. October is the month dedicated to "The Sanctity of Life". Pope Francis, in his address to the U.S. Catholic Bishops, on September 23rd, lists people who deserve protection: ***"the innocent children who die of hunger or from bombings, immigrants who drown in search of a better tomorrow, the elderly and the sick who are considered a burden, the victims of terrorism, wars, violence and drug trafficking. It is wrong then to look the other way or remain silent."***

As Christians, we need to live out the truth that all life is sacred from conception until natural death. We can encourage, support and help women who are in the midst of a difficult pregnancy; lovingly minister to women who have had an abortion; give to the poor, the hungry, the homeless; welcome refugees; tenderly take care of people who are ill, elderly or dying. We can contact government leaders, asking them to look within their hearts before making decisions on life issues, reminding them that only God has the authority to give life and take it away. Let us continue to pray that each God-given life is respected, protected and loved.

Jesus is with us throughout our lives in all its stages. He asks us to open our eyes to see Him in everyone who suffers. He wants us to love them; to reach out and help them – for it is in these precious children of God that Jesus lives!

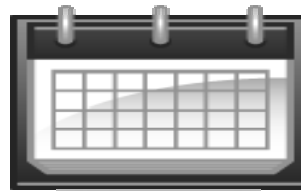
