Our New Organ

In September, we bought our new pipe organ. This is a gift from an anonymous donor to our parish in memory of Doris Elmore.

Our new organ was built in 1997 by the Reuter Organ Company for St. Joseph's Church in New York City. It has 20 ranks of pipes (or 1,220 pipes) ranging in size from a pencil to 16 feet. St. Joseph recently purchased a new organ and put the Reuter up for sale. It will be taken to Kansas to be rebuilt and then it will be installed sometime next year at St. Robert's.

It will be installed in our old Chapel, on the right hand of the altar. Some construction of the Sanctuary will be necessary, and the Tabernacle will again be placed in the Sanctuary under the cross.

The new organ will be named the Doris Elmore Memorial Organ.

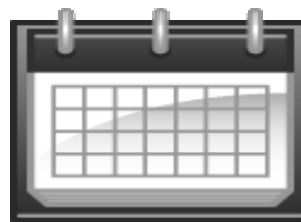
