After our long drought, even a little rain has brought new life to the earth. It is great to be able to say that brown is not the new green.

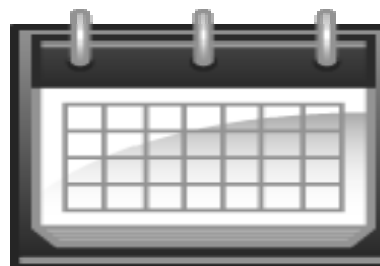
So too, after the pain of Christ's death, the apostles had their grief overcome by the news of the Resurrection. They found new life and hope in His victory over death.
