Dear Friends,

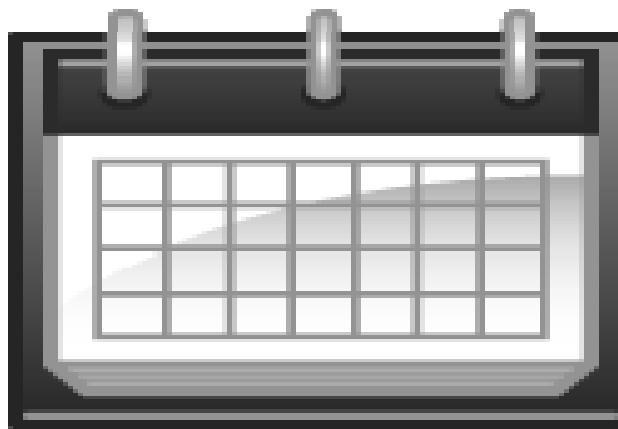
Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. I sit here on our deck, sipping Vanilla Chai tea, remembering a morning 44 years ago. Gene and I had been married for four years. Life was good. I was thanking God for Gene May. With a joyful heart, I prayed: "God, My Father, I know You. Jesus, I know You too. But Holy Spirit, I don't really know You. Help me to know You." **"Ask and you shall receive. Seek and you will find. Knock and it will be opened to you."** The next moment, our telephone rang. It was our friend Nancy St. John (who is now in heaven, where Gene is too). She told me that, on the following Saturday, there would be a Holy Spirit seminar at St. Luke's Church in Foster City. Nancy asked if Gene and I would like to go.

We did go and began to learn: Though our God is One, He consists of three distinct persons, each with His own work to do. The Father is our Creator; Jesus is our Redeemer and The Holy Spirit is our Sanctifier -- who, at this very moment, is living and working within us and all around us. He moves the Church; works in the Church and in our hearts, making each of us unique; yet together as One with all Christians. He loves us; encourages us; strengthens us; guides us; and fills us with His gifts. He opens the doors and invites us to bear witness to Jesus; to proclaim His love and mercy in all the areas of our life. He moves us to praise God; to pray to Him. That gentle prodding to do good things for others is the Holy Spirit. That evening we attended a Healing of Memories Service, where we forgave everyone who had ever hurt us. In forgiving (thanks to the Holy Spirit), we encountered Jesus. He gave us the awareness that His Spirit lives within us and will never leave us. It was then that our incredible spiritual journey began!

In today's Gospel, Jesus said to His disciples (and to us): **"I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when He comes, the Spirit of truth, He will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on His own, but He will speak what He hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming and He will glorify Me, because He will take from what is Mine and declare it to you."** The Most Holy Trinity lives within each of us. All we need do is open the door of our heart; ask Him to speak to us; then be still and listen to our God.
