## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

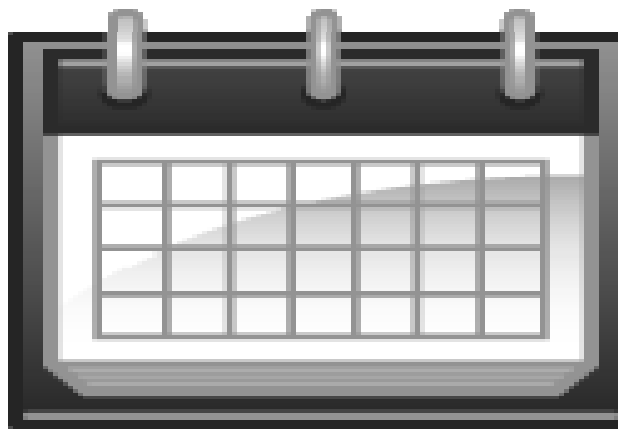

Dear Parishioners,  
 Do you remember your First Communion? On this Feast of the Body of Christ (which we older folks recall as Corpus Christi), it might be good to reflect on what is the same and what has changed. After the 4:30 Mass last Saturday, I asked Anna, a first grader, what will happen next year. She smiled and responded, "I make my First Communion!" I don't think she was excited about the dress and the family gathering which will happen, but at some level grasped that it is Jesus she will be receiving. We recall receiving Communion on the tongue and that we could never touch the host, out of respect for the Lord. Only the priest received the Cup; we never did. And only the priest could distribute the Eucharist. Now, our neighbors, friends and even family members distribute both the host and the cup with great respect. And we receive the host in the same hands which work all day, change a baby's diapers, and make dinner! At our First Communion celebrations last month, we sang "Come to the feast of heaven and earth! Come to the table of plenty! God will provide for all that we need, here at the table of plenty." The verses contain the invitation from the Lord himself: "O come and sit at my table where saints and sinners are friends. I wait to welcome the lost and lonely to share to the cup of my love." So no matter if we're feeling holy or sinful, we are encouraged to receive the Lord who is with us, regardless of how we're feeling. It is the same Lord we receive whom we first received decades ago or last month! The same Lord who healed and preached, who died and rose again for us, and promised he'd be with us always in his Spirit. It is the same Lord who fills us with his love and sends us forth to share that love. As Teresa of Avila wrote, "Christ has no body on earth but yours, no hands but yours." May we be his presence! S.
