Dear Friends,

On this lovely day in June, I sit here on our deck in Gene's garden. Looking over today's readings, I find the theme of each is God's mercy, love and forgiveness. There are times when guilt overtakes us. We worry that what we have said or done is unforgivable. In today's first reading from Samuel, David's confesses to God and to Nathan, **"I have sinned against the Lord."** Speaking through His prophet Nathan, God tells David (even though he has murdered Uriah's wife and taken her as his own): **"The Lord on his part has forgiven your sin: you shall not die"**.

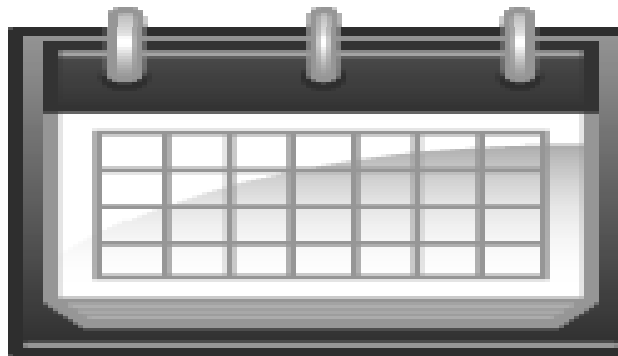
In the Responsorial Psalm, we pray with David: **"Lord, forgive the wrong I have done...I acknowledged my sin to You, my guilt I covered not. I said, 'I confessed my faults to the Lord,' and You took away the guilt of my sin."** There isn't a single sin, no matter how evil, that we could ever commit that Our God will not forgive if we but ask Him.

St. Paul, who had brutally persecuted Christians, tells us: **"I have been crucified with Christ, yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me...I live by faith in the Son of God who has loved me and given Himself up for me."** Jesus willingly and lovingly suffered and died for each one of us so that our sins would be forgiven. By His Cross and Resurrection, Jesus opened the gates of heaven to us and reconciled us with Our Father.

In today's Gospel, a woman prostrates herself before the feet of Jesus, covering them with her tears and drying them with her hair. She then kisses Jesus' feet and anoints them with her perfume. Jesus says to Simon, **"So I tell you her many sins have been forgiven because she has shown great love."** During His life here on earth, Jesus received sinners with divine goodness; He never refused them pardon. Neither will He refuse us pardon. All we need do is to call out to Him; confess our sins to Him and express our sincere sorrow. Jesus hurries to meet us. He is our Good Shepherd. He seeks after us (his lost sheep) and when He finds us, He puts us on His shoulders and carries us back to His fold. The One who forgives our sins shows us infinite love and mercy. The Name of God is Love and Mercy – Come to Jesus; He is waiting!
