Dear Parishioners,

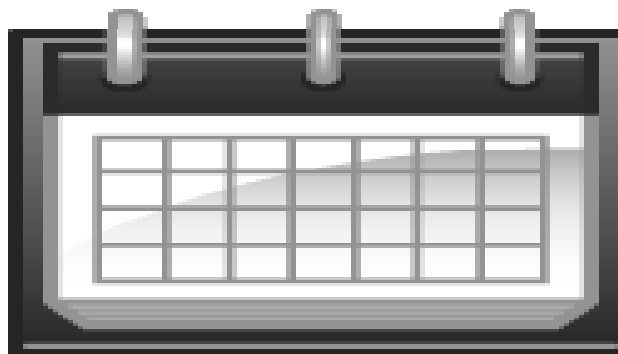
Last Sunday, 11 of us volunteered to serve almost 3000 lunches to our homeless brothers and sisters who live in the Tenderloin in SROs (Single Room Occupancy) or on the streets. There were also 12 or 13 young adults in their 20's and 30's volunteering as well because their friend Grace had asked them to celebrate her birthday with her by serving there. You may have read about a group of sophomores and juniors at Burlingame High who meet two evenings a week and on Saturdays doing cancer research. They began on their own, but now have a researcher who heard about their interest and is acting as their advisor.

How many people do you personally know who are making the world a better place because of their faithful, loving actions? Whether it is care-giving for a parent with Alzheimer's, driving a neighbor to regular doctor's appointments, or being patient with a difficult student, many individuals are affirming by their attentiveness that we are one human family.

St. Paul proclaims in today's second reading: "In Christ Jesus, you are all children of God through faith." He negates the societal barriers of his time: "there is no longer Jew or Greek...slave or free...male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus." The massacre which took place in Orlando last Sunday might challenge our sense of being one family, one in Christ even with those who may not be Christian and whose lifestyle we may not approve of or even understand. One of the women killed was married and present as a support to her son and his friends. May we pray for everyone who died, their loved ones, those who were seriously injured, and for the shooter and his family. And may each of us counter hatred with our own faithful, loving actions.
