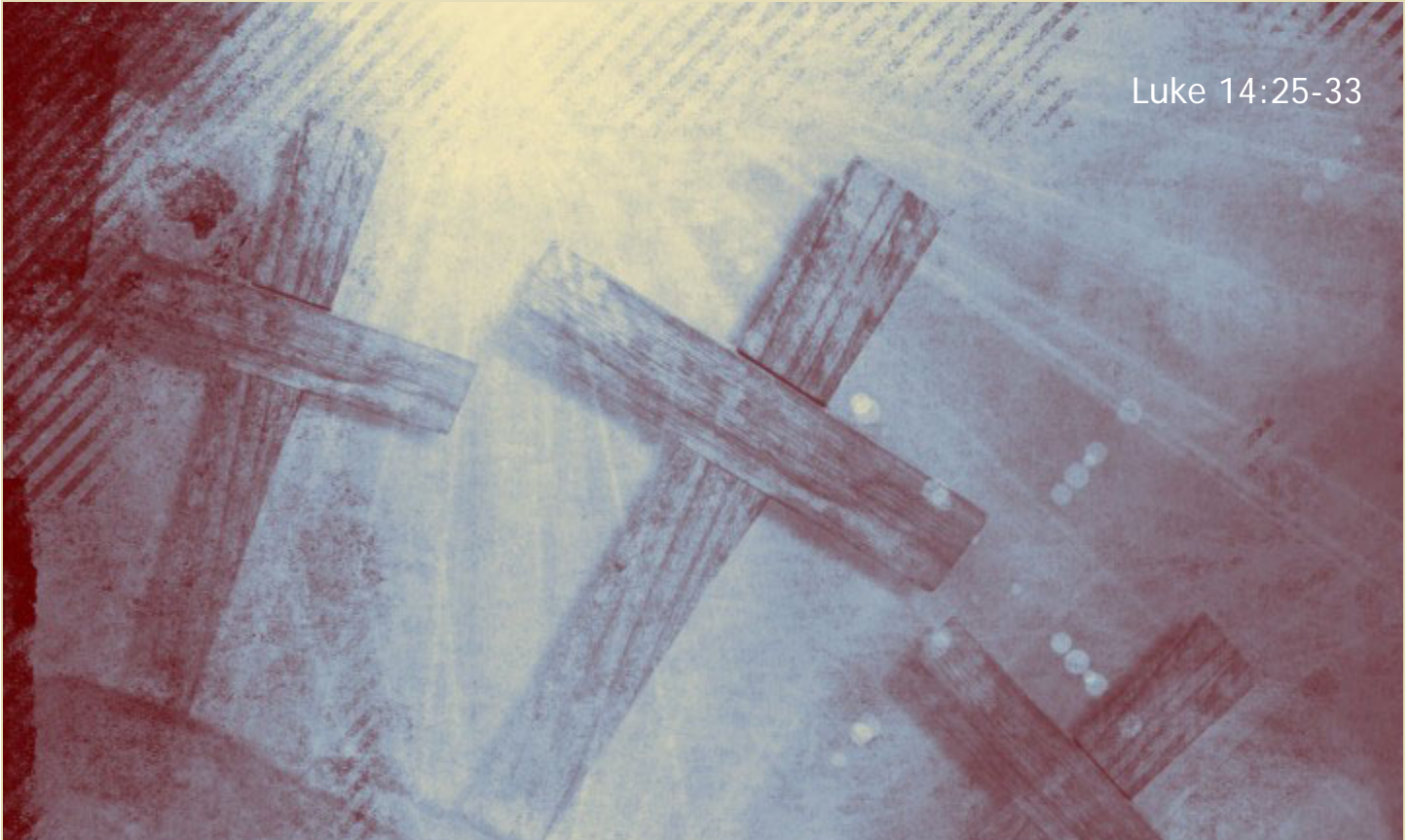

Adult confirmation is available on an individual basis. Please contact the rectory to make arrangements.

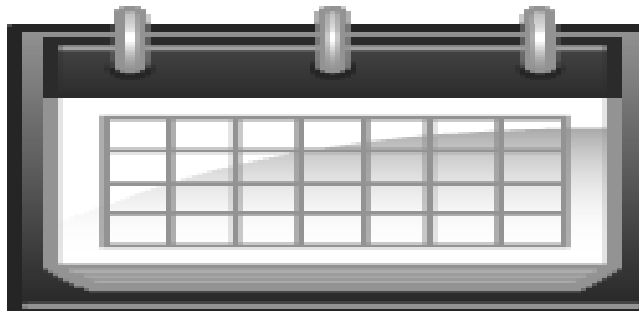
Dear Friends,

Sitting here on our deck in Gene's summer garden, sipping Irish Breakfast tea, I see the theme of today's readings is "Humility". I wonder: Do I know anyone who is truly humble? Almost immediately I remember a little 8-year old girl with curly black hair and smiling Irish blue eyes. We had just moved to our home on 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Sitting on our front steps, Shirley, Joan, Bob and I curiously watched this little girl come "flying" across the street. Landing in front of us, she breathlessly announced: "I'm Mary Margaret Huvane; welcome to our block." And so our 75-year friendship began! Every day thereafter, Mary would "fly" across the street to our house. She was as excited as we were when our little brother Jack was born. He was her little brother too. In each stage of our long lives, Mary was there.

To believe in God, we must be humble, knowing that there is Someone greater than we are – that He is God and we are not. Mary never forgot this. She trusted God and accepted His Will in the good times and in the sad times (when her first baby boy died at birth and at the death of her beloved husband Johnny). To love, we need to be humble. God allows us to forget ourselves and love others. Every day, Mary forgot herself; loved and completely gave of herself to Johnny, their 7 children and 8 grandchildren, each of her friends, the children she taught at St. Cecilia's School and everyone God sent to her. Mary was lovingly obedient to God's plan for her life by being just who she was and not trying to be someone she was not. She was never critical or judgmental; she accepted and loved everyone. Mary had a great sense of humor and a musical laugh, which she often used to laugh at herself.

Humble people are a pleasure to be with and easy to live with. They make wonderful friends and are filled with joy and peace; forgetful of themselves; kind and compassionate to those around them. This was Mary. She reflected an inner strength, knowing that the Holy Spirit lived within her. In Him, she found the support, encouragement and caring love to follow Jesus in her day-to-day world. Our beautiful friend Mary is and always will be that someone in our lives who really lived the virtue of "Humility". In the early morning hours of August 9<sup>th</sup>, Jesus gently carried Mary Margaret (Huvane) Greene to her home in heaven. "Mary, please save a place for us beside you and once again welcome us to your block."

We are currently accepting registration.

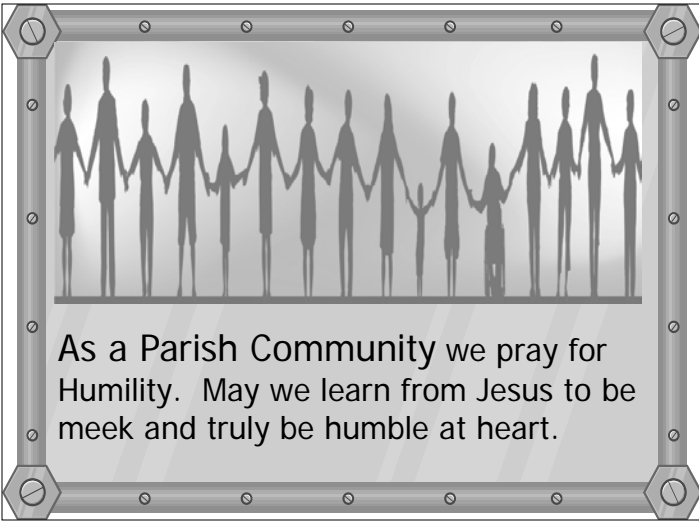
**Classes for grades 1-5** begin on Tuesday, September 13 at 3:30pm;

**COMPLETING OUR NEW ORGAN**

On Monday, August 15, the exterior pipes of our new organ were packed away. Our parishioner, Pat Uniacke, is extending the organ grill up to the ceiling of the sanctuary. This will enable the organ to speak more clearly and loudly into the church. This work will take about 2 weeks.

In September, Reuter Organ Company will come to reset the large external organ pipes, fix small problems with the new organ, and add additional pipes.

We still hope to have the formal blessing and inaugural recital in the Fall or after the New Year.
