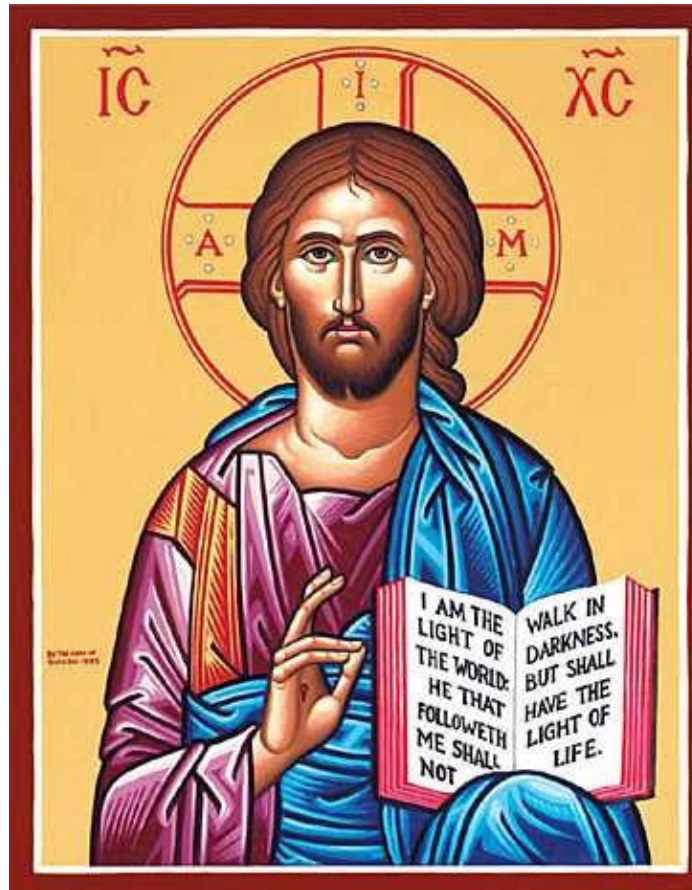

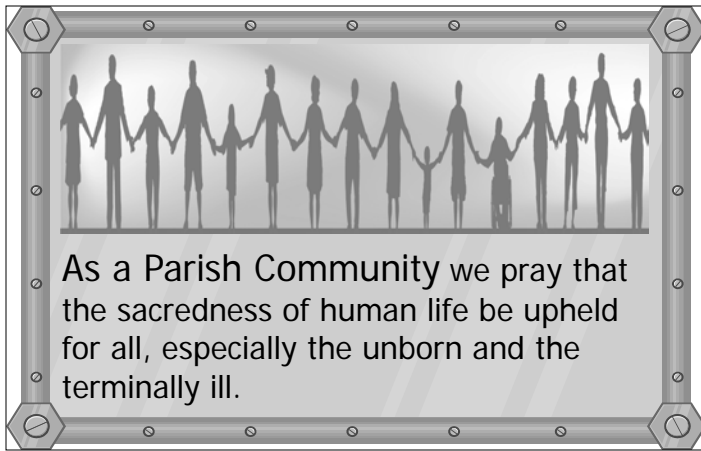
Dear Saint Robert Parishioners,
