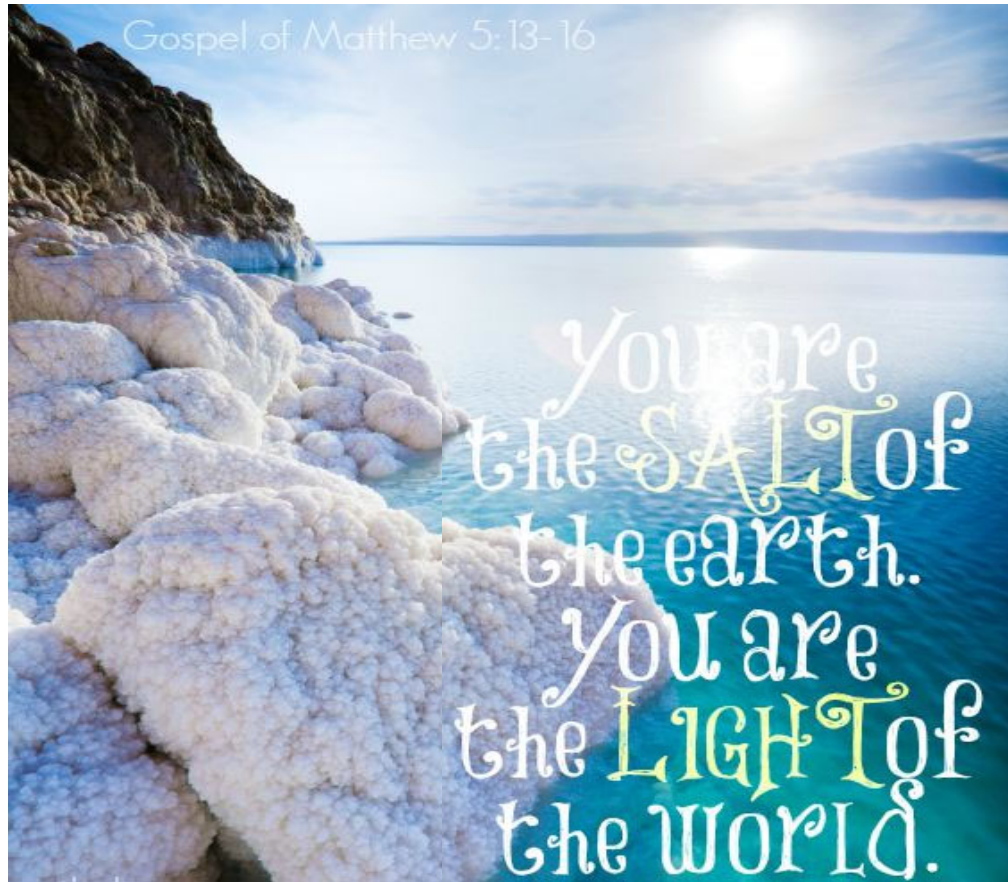

Dear Parishioners,

The readings today are challenging! The message from the Lord via the prophet Isaiah is very specific: give food to those who are hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked and don't turn away from your own people! As a parish community, we do feed the hungry through St. Vincent de Paul, the Second Harvest grocery distribution and donations of food and money to our Catholic Worker. Sheltering the oppressed and the homeless is our Christian obligation.

In the gospel, Jesus calls his disciples – and us – the salt of the earth and the light of the world. If salt brings out the flavor of food, perhaps our "saltiness" can draw forth the uniqueness in others, helping them to see gifts they don't even know they possess! God is counting on us to let our light shine before others. Jesus implies that when people see our good deeds, they'll figure out that God is the one who enables us to do such loving actions. Don't each of us know someone whose light is so bright, whose interactions with others are so compassionate that they remind us of God's goodness?

How about focusing on salt and light this week? Might we experience someone's "saltiness" calling forth something new in me? Might my light be shining clearly enough to guide another's path?

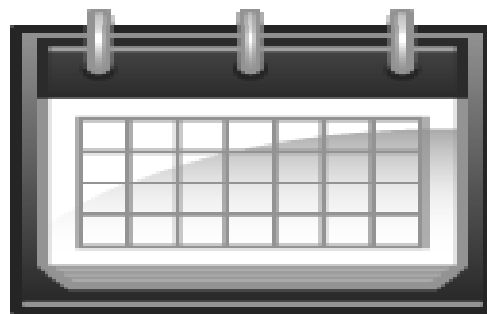

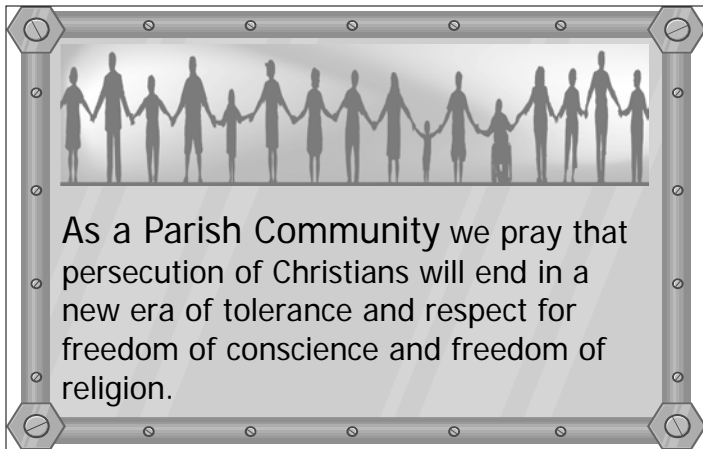
