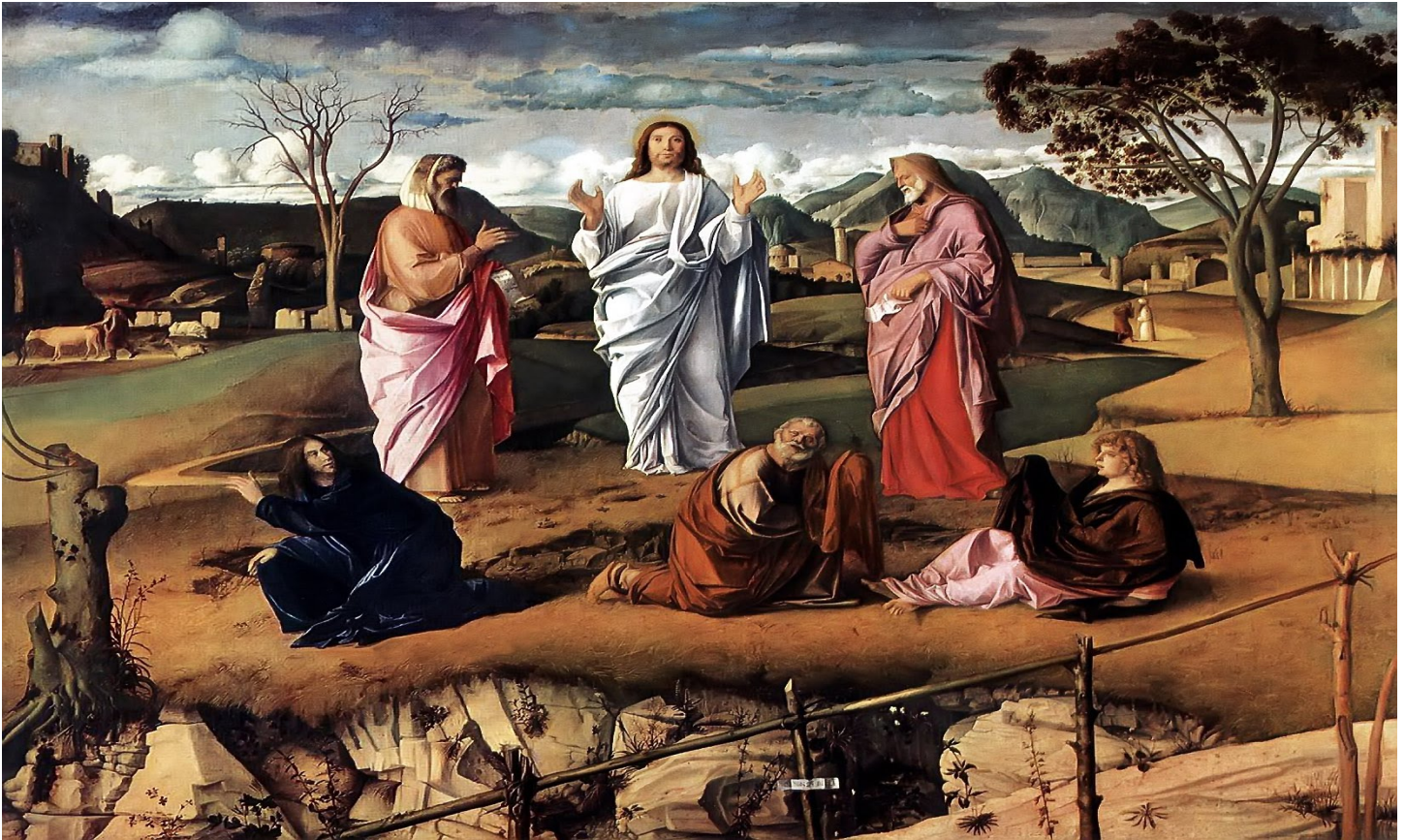

Dear Parishioners,

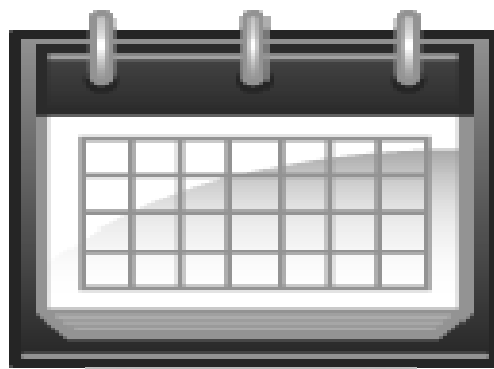
Last Sunday at the 11:30 Mass, we witnessed the first shoots of new life coming into our parish and the universal Church! Three women, Carolyn Gibson, Courtney Johns, and Victoria Myracle and two men, Chris and Dennis Cruzen, took the next step in their RCIA journey of becoming Catholics. Another woman, Alice Matsuda, is preparing for her confirmation through the same process. RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults and was reinstated by Vatican II as a community-based process to help those interested in experiencing the teachings and practices of the Catholic Church by learning about the scriptures, getting to know parishioners, and sharing in the Sunday liturgy.

The Lenten season actually evolved in the early Church as a time of intense preparation for those wanting to follow Jesus, eager to belong to the community of his disciples, even at the risk of persecution and death. Over the ages, Lent became a season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving (works of charity), a time of renewal for those already part of the Christian family. We'll be praying for these six (and ourselves) on the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent. They'll be listening with us to God's word as the Spirit urges each of us to that change of heart which will make us more like Jesus. For any of us who are wondering what we might "give up" for Lent, there are many clear invitations in the gospel. I'm going to focus on Matthew 25:11-46.

Come to weekday Mass, if your schedule allows; try to spend 10 minutes each day thanking God for the gift of life and remembering those who need your prayers. Come to confession on a Saturday, or make an appointment with one of the priests for another time. I'll be leading a Lenten morning of reflection on Saturday, March 25 in the church after the 8:30 am Mass until noon, followed by lunch. It will include a presentation, quiet time, and some sharing. You are most welcome to join us. May the Spirit open our hearts for a fruitful Lent!

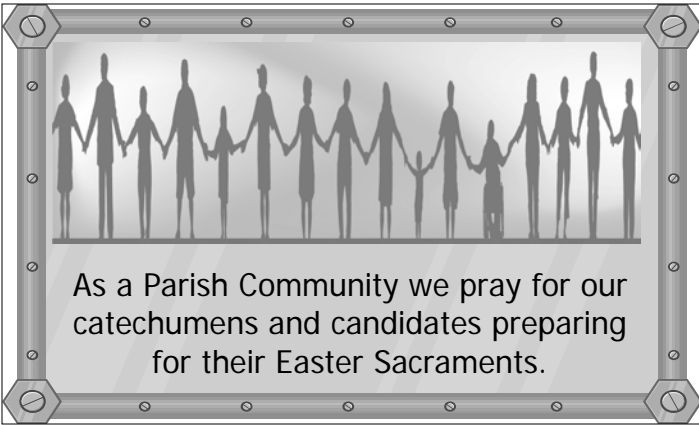
