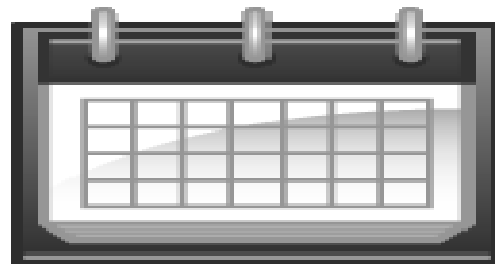
### **Morning of Reflection with Sr. Sheral**
