Dear Parishioners,

This past Tuesday was World Refugee Day and serves as a reminder of the unprecedented 65.3 million people who have been forced from their homes due to war, drug dealing and other violence. Syrians are the largest group, followed by Afghans, South Sudanese and Somalis. Maryknoll Office for Global Concerns (www.ogc@maryknoll.org) estimates that 34,000 people are forcibly displaced every day as a result of conflict or persecution. Our Holy Father insists that "Refugees are not numbers, they are people who have faces, names, stories and need to be treated as such." He has launched a new website for the Vatican's Migrants and Refugees Section which he personally directs.

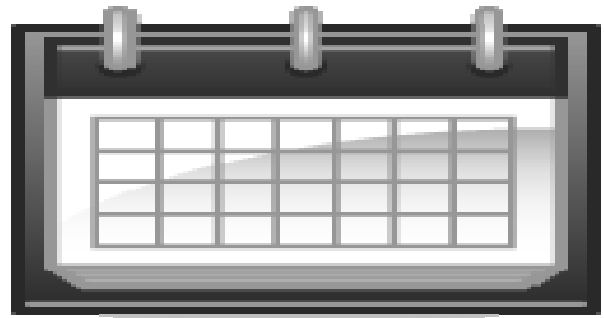
