Adult confirmation is available on an individual basis. Please contact the rectory to make arrangements.

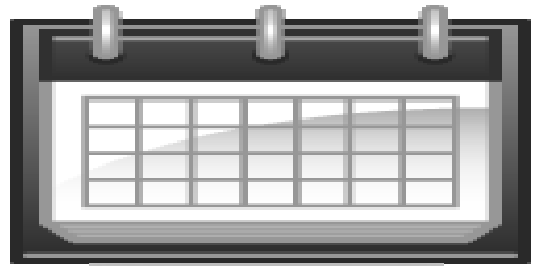
Dear Parishioners,
 With the first reading comparing God's word to seed and the gospel conveying Jesus' parable about the sower and the seed, we might be reminded of creation and Pope Francis' encyclical, *Laudato Si*. Pope Francis attracted the attention of the whole world with his encyclical, but he is not the first to wake us up to the need to take action. In 2001, our United States Bishops Conference wrote: There are three themes from Catholic Social Teaching that apply in a particular way to the Church's concern for the environment. First, concern for the environment calls us to respect human life and dignity. Second, as the world becomes increasingly interdependent, we have a call to promote the common good and the virtue of solidarity. Finally, in caring for the environment, we have a special responsibility to the poor and vulnerable, who are most affected and least heard.

In terms of our care for the environment, how are we doing? The Catholic Climate Covenant suggests simple ways we can begin to take the Holy Father's recommendations seriously: praying with and for creation; living more simply by lowering your family's carbon footprint; and advocating to protect our common home. Why not sit down with the members of your household to discuss how you might put Pope Francis' encyclical into practice? How about a family walk after dinner with everyone sharing the aspect of the neighborhood he/she most enjoys?

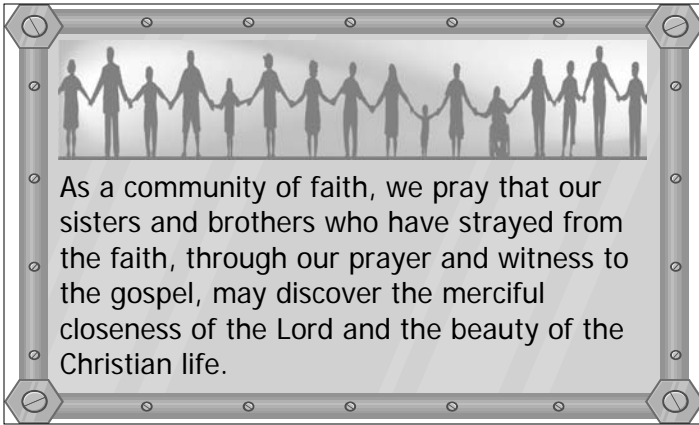
