## Save the Date

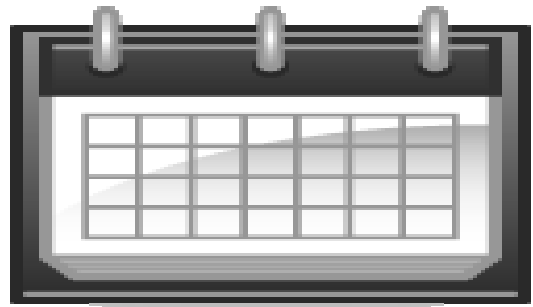
At long last, the date has been set for the blessing and dedication of our new pipe organ.

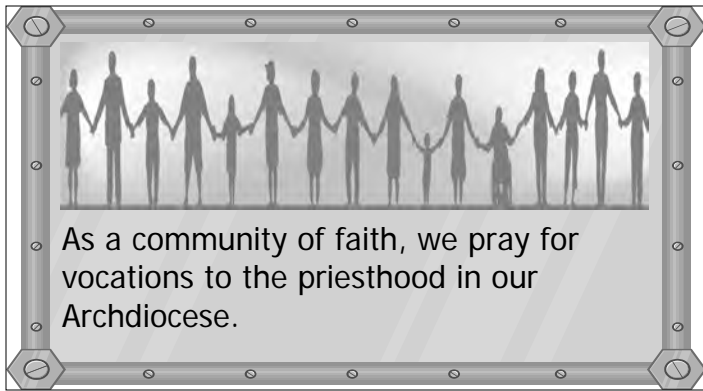
